



Transportation Form-

everything you need to know (and more)



We really look forward to seeing your child at camp!

This **IMPORTANT** form helps us determine how your child will be getting to and from camp.

*Needs to be completed by each family FOR EACH CAMPER

*Submitted no later than March 5th

*It can be found in [your Decoma Account](#)- click on Forms & Documents to complete the form entitled Transportation Info.

If your address has changed, PLEASE email [Sami](#) and indicate your NEW address. Writing in your new address on this form will NOT change your address in the system.

WE ARE FLEXIBLE- If your camper's transportation needs change throughout the camp week (i.e., bus one way/car one way and/or bus some days and parent transport some days), you are able to select this option on the transportation form.

Please note that once you have made your selection (either transportation by bus, transportation by car, OR extended before or after care), you may not have the option to change your selection unless you decide not to utilize the bus.

If your camper is attending LESS than 5 days a week,

- Please make a comment in the notes section which days you would like them to attend
- IF YOUR MODE OF TRANSPORT DOES NOT CHANGE day to day, you do **not** need to utilize the drop down menu to select a mode for each day.
- IF YOUR MODE OF TRANSPORT CHANGES day to day-the system will have you select a transportation mode for each day of the week-- even the days not attending

DOOR-TO-DOOR TRANSPORTATION BY BUS (BUS OPTION):

- **The estimated AM pick-up time for your camper(s) will be provided closer to camp (once bus routes have been finalized)**
 - We won't know this information until we receive all the forms and create the routes- this likely won't happen until the end of the May!
- **Shortened Day buses depart from camp at approximately 1:25 pm**
- **Full Day buses depart from camp at approximately 3:25 pm**
- ***Please be outside and ready to greet your campers when they arrive home**

Please know that due to bus route configuration and assignment, if you do not choose the bus option on your Transportation Form there is a strong possibility you will not be able to add

your campers to a bus route at a later date. IF THERE IS A POSSIBILITY THAT YOU WILL REQUIRE BUS SERVICE (EVEN OCCASIONALLY, PLEASE SELECT THE BUSING OPTION).

TRANSPORTATION BY CAR (CAR OPTION): Parents will be able to opt out of bus service and pick up and/or drop off their campers.

- AM Drop-off times will start at approximately 8:40 am and go until 9:10 am (if you cannot make it during those times, we ask that you wait until 9:45 to drop your camper(s) to allow for our buses to arrive and unload safely.
- SHORTENED DAY buses will depart from Decoma at approximately 1:25. If you are picking up your camper(s), please arrive at 1:30 pm.
- PM Pick-up times will begin at 3:30 and go until approximately 4:00 pm. **If you need to pick your camper up early, we ask that you notify us and pick up before 3:00 pm.**

EXTENDED CARE (AM or PM CARE OPTIONS):

Due to staffing constraints, we have a limited number of spaces available for our extended care program and spots are reserved for those families that require these services (and will not be utilizing the bus service).

- Before care campers can be dropped off between 8:00 -8:30 am! If you do not arrive before 8:30, you will be unable to drop your campers until 8:45 am as the lot is reserved for staff arrival from 8:30-8:45. Due to our limited parking lot space, camper drop-off during this time window poses a safety concern. If you arrive after 8:45, you are likely to end up in our regular camp drop-off line.
- Those staying after camp may be picked up any time after 4:00 but NO LATER THAN 5:00.

Please log into [your Decoma Account](#) and click on Forms & Documents to complete the form entitled Transportation Info. You will need to submit this form no later than March 5, 2026. If we have not received your form by then we will assume you will be utilizing the CAR-parent drop off and pick up option.
